

QUEEN'S BIRTHDAY FLYPAST ROUTE & TIMINGS

- 12 JUNE 2010 (All times LOCAL)



The main formation (WINDSOR) including RAFAT (Red Arrows) form up over the sea east of Southwold. BBMF (MEMORIAL FLIGHT) hold at Waterbeach north of Cambridge and fly a separate route to Fairlop Station (the Initial Point – IP) at 150 Kts. WINDSOR, flying at 270 Kts, leave the hold to achieve 40 secs separation with MEMORIAL FLIGHT over the Palace. Subsequent elements of the formation overfly the Palace every 30 secs.

RAFAT flying at 360 Kts, will then fly a dog leg to reduce speed and regain 30 secs separation by RAF Northolt (holding a Families Day), whilst BBMF turn right immediately after the Palace and depart via the RAF Museum at Hendon. WINDSOR & RAFAT then overfly the At Home Day at RAF Halton and the RAF Brize Norton Families Day, where they disperse and recover to their home stations.
